

Thursday 27th August

10.00 a.m Meet with the English speaking tour guide to visit the Ducal Palace of Urbino, a splendid example of Renaissance architecture. The Palace hosts the National Gallery of Marche where you can admire the art of major Italian artists to admire including Raffaello and Piero della Francesca.

12.00 p.m Meet the Scuola Italia bus driver at the bus station. Departure for Urbania with private bus. Arrival in Urbania at 12.45 p.m. Lunch at an Italian *trattoria* to taste our local food.

03.00 p.m Ceramic painting lesson. The city of Urbania, famous in the 1500s for ceramic production, continues its artistic tradition in the workshops of local artists. It will be a practical course. With the help of a skilled ceramist, every participant will decorate their own piece and will be able to take it home as a souvenir. The piece will be delivered on Saturday, after the last firing process.

Friday 28th August

At the evocative *trattoria*, the skilled Chef will teach us the art of eating well according to the best Italian culinary tradition. Participants will prepare various dishes that will be enjoyed together. The cooking lesson will end after lunch.

03.30 p.m Departure for Piobbico, a picturesque medieval village at the feet of Monte Nerone where the impressive Brancaleone Castle stands.

05.30 p.m. Departure for Urbino.

Saturday 29th August

10.00 a.m Meet the Scuola Italia bus driver at the bus station. Departure for Urbania. A guided walking tour in the city including a visit to a Bramante Theatre. The theatre is a prototype of Italian Classic Theatre. There will be also a visit to the famous church of the dead in which one can see the phenomenon of natural mummification.

12.30 p.m. Lunch in a *trattoria* to taste our local foods

03.30 p.m Departure for Sant'Angelo in Vado city tour. A visit to the city and a visit to the Domus of the Myth, one of the most important archaeological treasures that came to light in the last 50 years.

05.30 p.m Departure for Urbino.
